Bylaws Amendment Defining "designated agent" for Directors Inspections

Rationale: The existing text does not define the eligibility of the designated agent, Article 12, Section 4 defines the inspection rights of members and is more limited than that of Directors. It stands to reason that the designated agent should be more clearly defined. This amendment specifies other current Directors and LSB members.

Existing Text:

Article Twelve, Corporate Records, Report and Seal, Section 3: Directors: Inspection Rights

Every Director, or his or her designated agent, shall have the absolute right at any reasonable time to inspect and copy all of the Foundation's books, records and documents of every kind and to inspect the physical properties of the Foundation.
